SWIMMING POOL

Pool Rules: In addition to rules posted at pool sites, please abide the following rules.

2. No containers are allowed in or on the pool deck.
3. No use of inappropriate language.
4. Diapers or pull-ups are not allowed in pool.
5. Do not use the pool if you have open wounds.
6. Proper swim attire is required.
7. No running/jumping around or in the pool.
8. Floats are not allowed, but you can use a noodle without attached extensions.
