### SWIMMING POOL

Pool Rules: In addition to rules posted at pool sites, please abide by the following rules.

1. Residents must always accompany their guests in the Guest Pool.
2. No containers are allowed in or on the pool deck.
3. No use of inappropriate language.
4. Diapers or pull-ups are not allowed in the pool.
5. Do not use the pool if you have open wounds.
6. Proper swim attire is required.
7. No running/jumping around or in the pool.
8. Floats are not allowed, but you can use a noodle without attached extensions.
